



### **How to make noseband covers – helping donkeys and horses of Egypt**

Step 1) Cut fabric 11" wide x 7" deep.

Step 2) Cut Velcro into an 11" length strip.

Step 3) Sew length of velcro down one fluffy side. It needs to be sewn as glue deteriorates in the heat.

Step 4) Sew the other side of the velcro on the cotton side so it is like a tube when the velcro is stuck together.

It is important that they are sewn robustly as they will see a fair amount of wear and tear! The tube makes a cover that can easily be put on and taken off nosebands, especially the nasty chain ones.
